- ❖ **What infrastructure is currently in the school?**



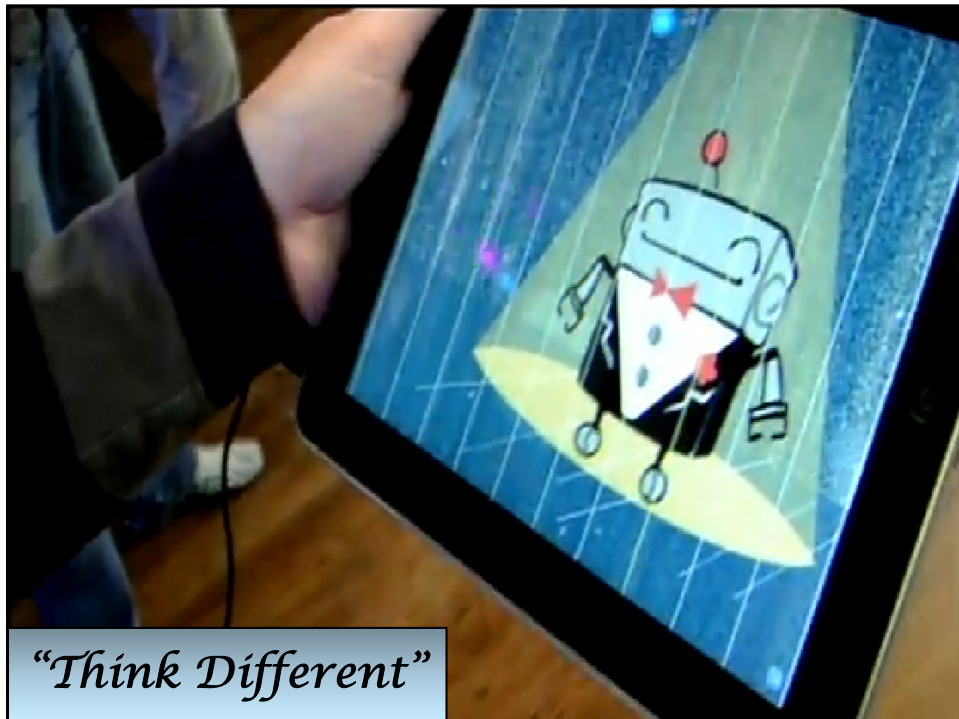
## *Why the iPad??*

- ❖ **Long battery life – lasts the school day**
- ❖ **Minimal technical support required**
- ❖ **Less chance for Viruses**
- ❖ **Availability of apps**

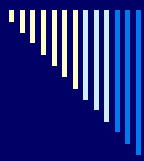


## How do I use the iPad

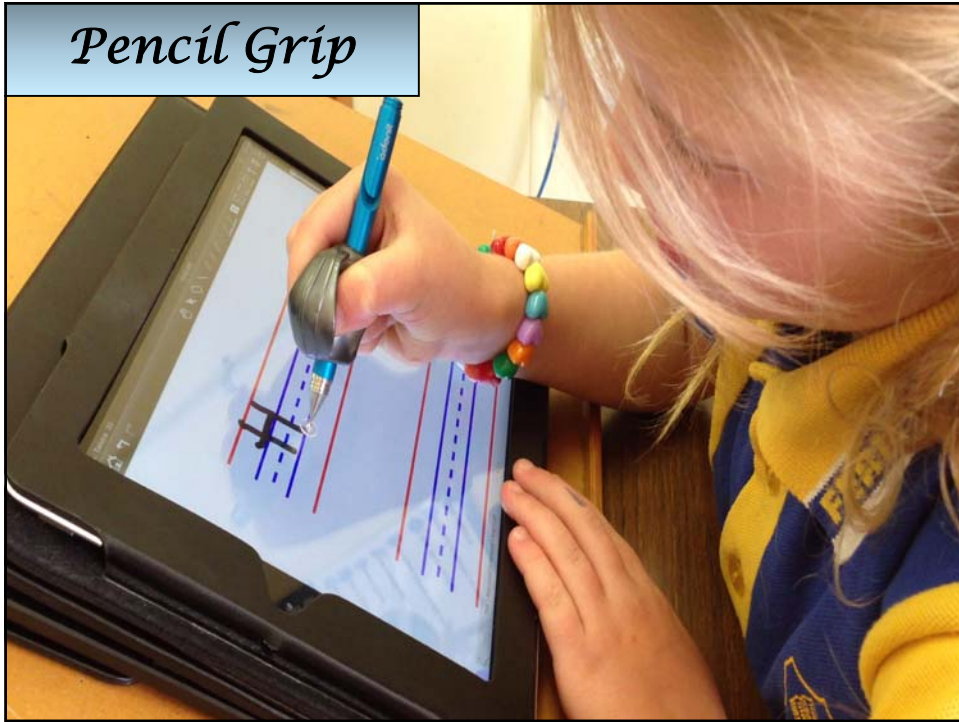




## Print

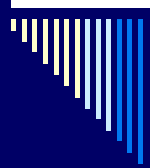
