## Principles and Practice - Background

- 2004 launch of SPEVI Principles and Standards
- Global and national developments since 2004
  - Legislation
    - Australian Disability Standards for Education (2005)
    - Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (2006)
    - Incheon Declaration and Framework for Action (2015)
    - Sustainable Development Goals (2015)
  - Advances in medicine and technology
  - Changing nature of VI service delivery in Australia



### Principles and Practice - Aims

- Principles underpinning the provision of inclusive, equitable, quality education courses, programs and support services
- Principles for setting objectives and establishing accountability measures within educational organisations and school systems
- Best practice guidelines for service providers to measure service delivery and performance



## Principles and Practice – Propositions

- All learners with vision impairment:
  - Have the capacity for inclusion in society, to the degree that is chosen by the individual
  - Have the right to access the services of a qualified specialist vision teacher and O&M instructor to meet identified needs
- Assessment, educational planning, and placement decisions must be driven by the individual needs of each learner
- Parents and educators form a vital partnership

# Professional Standards Elaborations – Background

- Regulated school systems, laws, policies and standards
  - AITSL Professional standards for teachers (2010) used to measure performance of specialist vision teachers Changing nature of specialist support in Australia
- What is a specialist vision teacher?
  - Widely known by education administrators, school leaders, teachers or parents?
  - Diversity across states/territories, geographical regions (urban and non-urban), and education sectors (public, private, faith-based)



#### Professional Standards Elaborations - Aims

- Elaborate on Australian Professional Standards
- Make explicit elements of high-quality, effective specialist teaching
- Provide service providers with a framework for reflecting on recruitment, professional practice and improvement of specialist teachers
- Support professional learning and career progression for specialist vision teachers
